We are seeking to appoint a highly motivated Research Fellow who will contribute to a range of projects, including the establishment of the National Transfusion Dataset (NTD), and help to drive forward research and practice in transfusion medicine. The Research Fellow's role will include analysis of clinical and laboratory transfusion datasets and continued development of linkages between hospital, laboratory, registry and prehospital data.

This is an exciting opportunity to be involved in the development of a unique national database, capturing for the first time an end-to-end picture of where, when, how and why blood products are used in Australia. Through the Blood Synergy, you will be part of an alliance of Australian and international leaders in transfusion, bleeding disorders, trauma medicine, and intensive care, as well as laboratory science, health policy and health economics.

Candidates will ideally have a doctoral qualification in a clinical or health-related discipline, and a track record of research excellence relative to opportunity. Clinical experience in a specialty field relevant to transfusion, such as haematology, emergency medicine/trauma, critical care, oncology, nursing, or paramedicine will be highly regarded.

This role is a full-time position; however, flexible working arrangements may be negotiated.
